Your student may be eligible for a .5 elective credit upon successful completion of 9th grade Warrior Academy.

To be eligible for credit each student must:

- ✓ Participate in all activities including community service activities

- ✓ Attend daily- Any student missing more than two (2) days excused or unexcused will not be eligible for credit.

A student can be withdrawn from the program and lose credit for the following reasons:

- ✓ Fighting
- ✓ Harassment, bullying, intimidation
- ✓ Under the influence of or possession of alcohol and/or drugs.
- ✓ Consistent inability to follow rules or requests from staff
- ✓ Excessive and/or consistent absences or tardies.
- ✓ Possession of a weapon

Any of the above offenses may result in further disciplinary actions as set forth by CPSD/CPHS policies and procedures, including but not limited to suspension from CPHS's regular school year.
